



Disaster Response Training Intensive October 25 - 27, 2018 Indianapolis, IN



Training Overview & Summary

The HFI Disaster Response Training Intensive consists of two days and two evenings of preparation for domestic service with HFI. This training is required to be qualified as a **Hope Force Reservist** - eligible for rapid deployment - often within 24-48 hours following a disaster event. The training consists of live speakers, as well as teaching filmed exclusively for Hope Force.

The program covers the following topics to prepare the Reservist for the emotional, spiritual and practical dynamics of disaster response:

- **Identity in Christ for the disaster responder** - Dan Sneed
- **Foundations of emotional & spiritual care (ESC)** - Dr. Kevin Ellers (Central Territory Disaster TSA)
- **Maintaining healthy & cohesive relationships in ministry** - Dean Sherman
- **Core principles for effective ministry** - Dave Buehring
- **How to be an appropriate caregiver** - HFI Staff
- **What to expect when responding** - HFI Staff
- **Disaster Response Principles** - HFI Staff

Upon successful completion of the training, graduates will be certified as **Hope Force Reservists**.

Extended Training & Preparedness:

We strongly recommend that all Reservists take First Aid/ CPR. Most cities or communities around the country provide for their citizens in these basic skills. Hope Force also recommends at least two designated Salvation Army* courses following the HFI Training Intensive course:

- Introduction to Disaster Services
- Training for Mobile Feeding Units and Social Services
- First Aid/ CPR (with certification)



*HFI and the Salvation Army have been national partners since 2005, and often work together across the United States and at times, internationally.
